 GREEN-BLUE GRANTS PROGRAM: CLEAN WATER THROUGH RESIDENTIAL IPM**

The Northeastern IPM Center is launching the Green-Blue Grants Program to promote clean water through residential integrated pest management. We will fund projects focused on educating residents of the Northeast about how using IPM in residential structures and landscapes can affect water quality. This education can take place through workshops, promotional materials, and other methods. ELIGIBILITY: This program is open to nongovernmental agencies, Cooperative Extension educators or county agents, land grant faculty and staff, eligible government staff, and private citizens who will be in contact with receptive audiences. Applicants must be based in a northeastern state or the District of Columbia.

AVAILABLE FUNDING: The maximum amount of money awarded will be \$2,500 per applicant. Total funds available for this grants program: approximately \$10,000.
