**New Jersey Pesticide Applicator Certification Exam Schedule for 2008**

**Background:**

New Jersey State Pesticide Applicator Certification exams are administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Pesticide Control Program (NJDEP PCP). The exams are scheduled monthly throughout the state in each of five host counties (Bergen, Burlington, Cumberland, Mercer, and Morris). Please note that the exam location for Morris County for 2008 differs from 2007.

Individual exams are based upon content contained in the corresponding New Jersey Certified Pesticide Applicator Core, Dealer, or Commercial Category manuals, available from your Rutgers New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES) Cooperative Extension County office. Private; Dealer; and Commercial Core and Category 3A, 3B, 3C, and 7A exams are closed-book exams. All other Category exams are open-book; you must bring your own manual with you to take the exam. There is a limit of one hour and forty-five minutes for taking each exam. You can take a maximum of three exams at each session (any combination of Core and Category).
