Update on NJ Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease Outbreak posted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Division of Fish and Wildlife listserv; Tuesday, September 25, 2007 10:27 AM.

An update on the Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease (EHD) outbreak in NJ is now available on the NJ DEP Div. of Fish and Wildlife Web site.

Sick deer from August through October, which are unable to stand and are drooling or emitting foam from the mouth and nose could be suffering from EHD. Similarly those found dead in the water or near the water with no apparent wounds should be suspect EHD cases and the OFWHF should be notified immediately by calling 908-735-6398 or the nearest DFW Regional Office.
